# SURFACE PREPARATION

<u>Concrete</u>: Ensure the surface is clean and free from atmospheric pollution which may require washing with clean

Asphalt / Tarmac: Ensure the surface is free from dirt, grease and other contaminants by using a detergent wash followed by a

freshwater rinse. Allow to dry. Do not use solvent
